Ms. Vickers obtained her master=s in nursing, advanced nurse practitioner stream, at the University of New Brunswick (UNB) and is currently primary health care nurse practitioner at the Nepisiguit Medical Clinic, Bathurst, and part-time lecturer at UNB, Bathurst.
