Whereas nursing practice is constantly evolving and that nurse practitioners must update their competencies regularly and constantly;

Whereas the continuing competence program does not state a mandatory number of continuing education hours;

Whereas other professions that make interventions and prescribe treatment plans are required to complete a minimum number of education hours each year in order to renew their registration;

Be it resolved that NANB considers the possibility of requiring a minimum number of hours of continuing education for nurse practitioners.
