



NP FAQ: Can NPs Prescribe Mifegymiso?

NPs in New Brunswick are authorized to prescribe Mifegymiso provided they have the necessary knowledge and skill to prescribe competently, safely, and ethically. NANB recommends that NPs who incorporate Mifegymiso prescribing into their practice complete the [Medical Abortion Training Program](#) provided by the [Society of Obstetricians and Gynecologists of Canada](#), or equivalent.

Health Canada has set requirements for the pharmaceutical company that provides Mifegymiso to mitigate the risks associated with this medication. These include providing prescribers with a medication guide and consent form to give to clients, as well as a 24-hour support line for clients needing assistance but unable to reach their healthcare provider or clinic.
