As an NP, is it mandatory for me to be a part of the Electronic Health Record, (EHR)?

It is strongly encouraged that NPs obtain EHR access so they can view Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP) information, along with all the other important patient information captured within the EHR. This is to ensure the best patient history possible, including prescription drugs that have been filled in New Brunswick, test results from the health authority (including lab work results), ED visits, etc.
